The NaiKun Project will help position B.C. as a leader in clean, renewable energy solutions. Located in Hecate Strait, up to 110 wind turbines will provide clean, renewable energy to meet B.C.'s growing electricity needs. The project includes HaidaLink, which will connect Haida Gwaii to the provincial transmission grid. HaidaLink would displace up to 26,000 tonnes of greenhouse gases currently emitted through diesel generation.
